Zoe Palmer, worked at Oskars since before the restaurant moved to Burleigh in 1997.

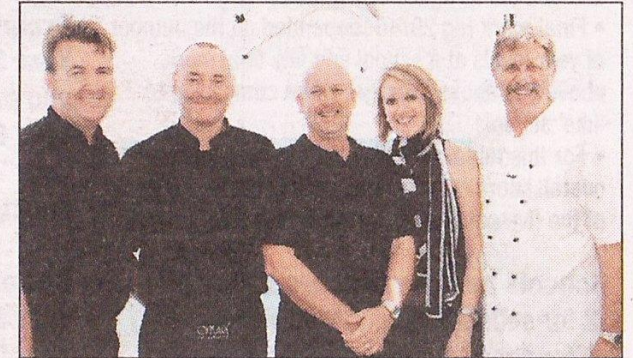
Brad joined Oskars in Coolangatta in 1993 as a 25-year-old and is now in charge in the kitchen with head chef and co-owner Marty.
