BURLEIGH'S Oskars restaurant is celebrating 30 years of fine dining on the Gold Coast.

Oskars Garden Restaurant opened on the corner of Elkhorn and Orchid Avenues, Surfers Paradise, in 1979, and was soon known for attracting celebrities.

In 1981, Oskars on the Beach opened at Greenmount. After the lease expired, the restaurant relocated in 1997 to Oskars at Burleigh on Goodwin Terrace.

Arguably the best restaurant location on the Gold Coast, Oskars has waterfront views along the beach to Surfers and has received multiple awards under the leadership of chef Marty Kollrepp and wife Mandy.

"By day, diners enjoy the foreground of white sand and inviting blue ocean," Mr Kollrepp said.

"By dusk, multi-coloured sunsets dominate the sky followed by kilometres of sparkling city lights and a sky full of stars."

Oskars' menu changes daily, depending on the availability of fresh ingredients.

"We have a long-standing relationship with regular suppliers, guaranteeing the freshest seafood available," Mr Kollrepp said.

To celebrate 30 years, Oskars has introduced a special three-course menu - \$39.90 for lunch and dinner, Monday to Thursday.
